- Validate experiences and help see patterns of abuse for safety planning purposes
- Give support workers further insight so that they can assist
- Capture detailed and reliable evidence to help report abuse to an online platform or take legal action

<b>Date</b> (date it happened or date you collected the evidence)	<b>What happened</b> (give the location and as much detail as possible)	<b>Evidence it happened</b> (screenshots, reports, people you told, etc. Include where this evidence is stored or saved.)	<b>Who you think did it</b> (name, social media handle, etc.)	<b>Evidence they did it</b> (screenshots, notes, etc.)	<b>Evidence still needed &amp; who has it</b> (witnesses, documents, etc.)
