

Setting good passwords



Making good passwords is hard. Making good passwords that you can remember for lots of different websites and apps is even harder.

Follow these steps:

- 1 Start with a regular word that's at least six letters long, like "bananas."
- 2 Replace some of the letters with numbers and symbols, like "6@n@n@s."
- 3 Make a phrase with the word, like "ilike6@n@n@s."
- 4 Replace some of the new letters, like "!!like6@n@n@s."
- 5 Add the first and last letter of the account the password is for, like "f!!like6@n@n@s" (for Facebook).
- 6 Now turn the page over and see if you can remember it later!
